Exclusive use at Fowlescombe Farm begins with a simple idea: the whole valley, the land and its produce, its chefs, it's sanctuary like spaces, and the suites, are all yours.

Fowlescombe becomes the backdrop for whatever brings you together. The farm and fresh Devon air works just as naturally for private celebrations as it does corporate offsites and leadership retreats. Brand campaigns, editorial shoots and creative residencies settle in beautifully to cinematic surroundings that are not a parody of the British countryside, but the real deal.

Weddings that feel as though you're being hosted at a family country house; milestone celebrations toasted over long lunches, and multi-generational get-togethers with plenty of room to roam. And wellness retreats are perfectly at home in a place where the farm and seasons set a softer pace.

GETTING TO US

Fowlescombe Farm sits between Dartmoor, England's last great wilderness, and the South Devon coast, home to hidden coves and vast beaches, pastel harbour towns and some of the UK's finest seafood.

WEDDINGS

With the whole farm exclusively yours, Fowlescombe becomes your hidden countryside haven; somewhere to gather and settle in for celebrations, before returning to the world newly married.

Ceremonies can take place beneath open skies on the lawn or inside *The Greenhouse* lined with greenery. A choice of spaces allows the day to feel fluid, not fixed: garden cocktails and canapés on the terrace, your wedding breakfast in *The Refectory*, speeches in *The Farmhouse*, dancing long into the evening with firepits under the stars.

Executive Chef Elly Wentworth will create wedding menus shaped by the seasons, served however feels most like you: sharing-style feasts, elegant plated dinners, outdoor over fire. Decorations can be from the land itself, and when you want something beyond what we grow here, we have a trusted circle of local suppliers at our fingertips.

Reception spaces can accommodate up to 60 people, with suites sleeping up to 24 overnight guests for restful ends to celebratory days. Everything is here, in one place.

Wellness retreats

We can shape a Devon wellness retreat that is just as you picture it, providing shared spaces, accommodation for up to 24 guests, experienced facilitators where needed, and food grown and served with care. The farm's own regenerative approach, placing biodiversity, healthy soils and respect for the land at the heart of everything, forms the perfect foundation for wellness in all its forms.

Creative retreats

Creative residencies find inspiration here too. Photographers, artists and writers gravitate towards the quality of light, the unique motions of a working farm and the seasonal shifts in Devon landscape. Interiors are calm and light, with space to create, ponder, relax and gather.

✿ The Farmhouse

The original Victorian Farmhouse still carries the warmth of a family home within the farm, all cosy terracotta sofas, sheepskin armchairs and art by local names inspired by Devon landscapes. The expansive living space features two seating areas and seating for eight at the long oak table, while a dedicated kitchen space and table with space to seat six is just beyond. French doors open onto a terrace that wraps around *The Farmhouse* and pours over views across the pond, meadow and valley beyond.

Its purpose changes with each exclusive use; sometimes it is a place to gather guests before vows are made and to retreat between celebrations, other times becoming a meeting space for strategy sessions or a setting for brand campaigns and editorial shoots.

🌿 The Greenhouse

Flooded with natural light and surrounded by the softness of productive planting that supplies our kitchen, *The Greenhouse* is one of the farm's most atmospheric spaces.

Couples often choose *The Greenhouse* as their wedding ceremony space, framed by greenery and open skies beyond the glass. For retreats, it transforms into a workshop studio with acres of natural light, ideal for yoga, creative sessions and conversations. As evening draws in, it plays host to drinks receptions and long table dinners. *The Greenhouse* is a space that feels both indoors and out, connected always to the landscape that surrounds it.

☼ The Refectory

Just as the kitchen tends to become the heart of all great gatherings, *The Refectory* at Fowlescombe Farm does too. An open kitchen brings theatre to mealtimes at the long, oak table, in a communal space where conversation flows as easily as the wine list (and it is a very good wine list indeed). *The Refectory's* purpose shifts over the course of an exclusive use stay; as practical a meeting space as it is a beautiful dining space.

OUR SUITES

Where You'll Stay

Fowlescombe unfolds across ten luxurious suites, reimagining our timeworn stone barns and original Victorian farmhouse. Arranged in clusters around the retreat, each suite offers space and privacy between time to gather.

An ode to their surroundings, each suite layers local oak with wool from our own rare Manx Loaghtan sheep, reclaimed stone from our quarry, and views over meadow, field and orchard. Some feature private terraces, while others are warmed by woodburning fires or have deep, freestanding baths. Together, they accommodate up to 24 overnight guests, in spaces ranging from 25m² to 80m².

All suites feature complimentary Wi-Fi, superking beds made with the wool of our own flock, loose-leaf tea and fresh coffee, and natural skincare from Pelegrims.



OUR FOOD

Food is one of the great heroes in the story of Fowlescombe Farm: seasonal, generous, gathered from the gardens and grown on the farm. Much of what we serve, we grow and raise ourselves. What we can't grow, we source from local producers who share our ethos on good food with good intentions.

Menus here are shaped by our Executive Chef Elly Wentworth, who will work with you to tailor food to the unique appetites of your own exclusive use event: long table feasts, outdoor cooking over fire, candlelight in *The Refectory*, leisurely breakfasts in *The Greenhouse* and sharing-style buffets that bring together the best of the season. However it looks, the emphasis is on food that is sourced well, cooked well, and which leaves your guests feeling very well fed.



A STAY THAT GIVES BACK

An exclusive use stay at Fowlescombe becomes part of a wider story: one where the land is cared for, biodiversity returns and the future of the countryside is shaped in a small but meaningful way.

At Fowlescombe, regenerative and sustainability principles are not just claimed, but lived daily. We are a working regenerative farm, where ethical farming practices, thoughtful design and thoughtful stewardship of the land combine to create something rare: a luxurious rural retreat that gives more than it takes.

Our native-breed animals graze rotationally on herbal pastures, with no artificial fertilisers, pesticides or soy-based feed. Our low-intensity approach helps sequester over 900 tonnes of carbon into the soil each year. Our gardens are fully organic, nourished with compost made from farm and food waste rather than toxic fertilisers.

Every guest of Fowlescombe Farm becomes part of a living system that restores more than it consumes.



☼ Curated Days

One of the luxuries of having the farm entirely to yourselves is the freedom to shape the days as you wish. The flow of your time here can be loosely held or carefully choreographed by our team ahead of your stay: coastal strolls and moorland hikes, wild swimming, regenerative farm tours and private yoga classes are just some of the experiences we can weave into a curated itinerary.



ON THE FARM

Many of the most memorable experiences begin right here at the farm. We can tailor a bespoke calendar of onsite activities that are perfectly in step with how you'd like to spend time here.

Farm tours

Spend time with those who work our farm and tend our land, discovering the regenerative farming approach that sees the soil here thrive and ecosystems flourish.

Cookery demonstrations and workshops

Join Elly and our chefs as they bake our daily bread, pickle and preserve the garden's seasonal gluts, and make fresh pasta for the evening's plates.

Garden tours and experiences

Spend time with Head Gardener Shelley, learning just how our organic garden grows and how seasonality shapes both planting plans and plates. Walk rows of produce and polytunnels, discover how today's kitchen waste becomes tomorrow's compost, and reconnect with what it means to eat as the season offers.



BEYOND THE FARM

What You'll Do

Once you arrive, everything you need is here. But if you're looking to adventure further, we can arrange a host of ways to explore South Devon.

Dartmoor National Park is a ten-minute drive away, with activities ranging from guided hikes and horse riding to stargazing over the tors. Some of South Devon's best beaches are equally close: Mothecombe and Bigbury-on-Sea are just 20 minutes away, while the harbour towns of Salcombe and Dartmouth can be reached within 30 minutes. Sea swims and surfing, paddle boarding to the pub, coast path roams and forays into foraging can all be woven into your stay.
