A UNIQUE LUXURY FARM STAY

Fowlescombe Farm sits within a sheltered valley on the edge of Dartmoor, surrounded by 450 acres of rolling pasture, orchards, ponds and wildflower meadows. Heritage-breed animals graze the fields, gardens shift with the seasons, and views stretch towards the moor and South Devon coast.

Historic farm buildings sit at the heart of the estate, now home to guest suites and *The Refectory*, while the bright, contemporary *Greenhouse* offers a striking contrast.

For weddings, the feeling is one of complete immersion. The whole farm is exclusively yours. It becomes your hidden countryside haven; somewhere to gather your favourite people and settle in for celebrations.



TO MARRY

Fowlescombe offers three distinct ceremony spaces, each with its own atmosphere.

Filled with natural light and greenery, *The Greenhouse* blurs the boundary between indoors and out. Expansive yet calm, it offers a beautiful setting throughout the seasons.

The Lawn sits at the heart of the farm, surrounded by wildflower meadows and open Devon countryside. A relaxed setting beneath wide skies.

For smaller ceremonies or cooler months, *The Refectory* provides a more intimate alternative, with floor-to-ceiling windows opening onto the terrace and a warm, understated atmosphere inside.

For more intimate celebrations, a selection of other considered spaces offer a beautiful setting throughout the seasons.



TO CELEBRATE

The Reception

With the entire estate exclusively yours, celebrations can flow from garden cocktails on the terrace to dinner in *The Refectory* or long-table feasts in *The Greenhouse* or for our larger soirées, *The Stable Yard*, before continuing around the fire pits beneath Devon skies.

There is a sense of freedom in how weddings work here. Guests move between *The Farmhouse*, gardens, terraces and lawns, with the landscape becoming part of the celebration. From orchards and ponds to the ivy-clad manor house ruins, there is no shortage of places to gather.

As evening falls, candlelight fills the barns and *The Greenhouse*, music carries across the valley, and the farm settles into a softer pace. The setting feels generous yet wholly intimate.



TO REST

The Stay

Fowlescombe unfolds across ten luxurious suites, set within timeworn stone barns and the original Victorian farmhouse. Arranged in small clusters around the farm, each offers space and privacy between time spent together.

Local oak, wool from our own rare Manx Loaghtan sheep and reclaimed stone bring each suite closer to its surroundings. Private terraces, woodburning fires and deep freestanding baths feature throughout.

Together, the suites accommodate up to 24 overnight guests, in spaces ranging from 25m² to 80m². All suites feature superking beds, fresh coffee, loose-leaf tea and natural skincare from Pelegrims.

TO FEAST

Food sits at the heart of life at Fowlescombe. Much of what reaches the table is grown in our gardens or raised on the farm, alongside ingredients sourced from nearby producers who share the same thoughtful approach to farming and seasonality.

Executive Chef Elly Wentworth works closely with each couple to design menus that reflect their day. That might mean generous sharing feasts in *The Greenhouse*, candlelit dinners in *The Refectory*, or outdoor cooking over fire as guests gather on the terrace.

Wedding breakfasts here are designed to feel generous and relaxed. Seasonal produce is at the forefront, flavours reflect the landscape around you, and every meal is served with the confidence of a kitchen that understands exactly where its ingredients come from.



No two weddings at Fowlescombe are the same. Every celebration is thoughtfully shaped around you, your guests and the way you want the weekend to unfold. Think of this as a starting point.

THE GARDEN PARTY

A wedding that feels more like a summer celebration than a formal affair.

Exchange vows by the pond or beneath the orchard trees before the farm slips into celebration. Smoke blooms from the fire, long tables fill with generous food, and music echoes through the valley as guests wander between lawn games and the dance floor.
